



## David Walton Matthews

July 20, 1933 - February 1, 2016

David Walton Matthews, 82, of Longwood, FL passed away Monday, February 1, 2016.

David was born in Chicago on July 20, 1933. He and his family lived in Plandome, New York, where he grew up and attended school. He received his B.S. with honors in economics. from Georgetown University in 1956 and then served four years in the United States Air Force Strategic Air Command . He became a registered representative in the securities industry, first with Merrill Lynch, and then became a partner in Dean Witter and Company, serving as manager of its Boston location for seven years. In that capacity he held a seat on the Boston Stock Exchange. He served as a vice president of Continental Bank of Chicago and founded a money market mutual fund for the municipalities of Rhode Island, while living in New York State. He held a registration with the Securities and Exchange Commission as principal officer of an investment advisory company, and eventually became president of a local securities brokerage firm in Altamonte Springs.

David was a loving father and husband, and is survived by three sons: John, David, and Robert Matthews, all of Massachusetts, and by his wife of twenty-one years, Elsie Child Turner, of Longwood, Florida.

An informal memorial service will be held at the Episcopal Church of the Resurrection, E. Lake Brantley Dr., Longwood, Florida, at 3:30 p.m., Thursday, Feb. 11, 2016.
