Julian Norman Webber passed away on August 21st 2021 and went to spend eternity with His Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Upon graduating from Knoxville, TN East High School, Julian worked for the Southern Railroad Company and joined the Army National Guard Reserves. In 1964 He married Vivian Fawver Webber (surviving) and they had two children Jennifer Ann Dorr and Joseph Patrick Webber (both surviving). Julian also has five grandchildren Anthony, Brooke, Michael, Eric, and Benjamin as well as six great grandchildren.

In 1970, Julian founded Carriage House Realty in Knoxville, Tennessee, and ran that organization until moving the family to Florida in 1981 where he was a mortgage and real estate broker until his retirement in 2007.
