Nancy Jane Templeton, 60, a devoted mother and passionate educator died unexpectedly on Saturday, May 16 in Orlando, Florida. She was a self-employed tutor and a nanny. Prior to that, she was a reading specialist and teacher of exceptional students.

Nancy was a native of Goshen, New York, where she grew up and lived until receiving a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Economics from the State University of New York at Oneonta. She moved to Central Florida in 1984 and earned a Master's Degree in Exceptional Education with a specialty in Autism Spectrum Disorders from the University of Central Florida in 2015. Nancy was a compassionate advocate for people with disabilities. She loved mentoring and tutoring children and young adults.

Nancy was known for her big heart and made friends with everyone she met. She had a way of making those around her feel loved at all times and her sense of humor kept family and friends laughing, even when times were tough. She fulfilled her life's purpose of being a mother and poured her heart and soul into her children.


