“ My first memory of Karina was when we met in third grade. I remember how nice and sweet she was. And the thing is, as we ALL know, she never grew out of being nice and sweet.

I can say that because for the past two years, as I've battled cancer, respiratory failure, and a series of strokes that put me on life support and in the hospital for five months – throughout all of that -- Karina would text me, sometimes every day, asking me if I was ok and to remind me that she was thinking about me. Later, after I got home the hospital, Karina would come to my house when she could and just spend time with me. She even met me at the gym and helped the trainers as they taught me how to walk again. She never gave up on me.
