Andrew later moved to Orlando Florida where he lived with his dad, George Barrett and stepmother Marie Barrett. Andrew was a surveyor who surveyed many properties in Orlando. He was a hard worker who on his days off took care of the landscaping and lawn care for his Dad's property as well as found the time to retile the home for them.
