



Angela Bazzo

December 22, 1921 - September 21, 2014

Angela was born and raised in Fonzaso, Italy on December 22nd, 1921. Shortly before the start of WWII here in the United States she and her mother and sister immigrated to the United States. During the voyage her sister passed away due to illness. Her mother though also ill made it here to the United States where she died shortly thereafter leaving Angela her own a young girl in her early twenties. She was able to find work as a Nanny and housekeeper for a Jewish Doctor and his wife and family. She had settled in the Italian Community in Chicago and thru them she met our father Albert Bazzo who with his brother John Bazzo had also immigrated to the United States. Albert and his brother and three sister's- Mary, Dora & Vicky were all born in Alba, Iowa, but as a result of their mother Mary's death they were all sent to Fonzaso, Italy to be raised by an Aunt. As the War broke out in Europe, the three sisters arranged for passage back here to the US for the two brothers. Upon arriving back into the US., the federal authorities/Draft Board wanted to send him back to Italy in US Army, but he wound up in the Pacific. Before he left they were married in Chicago. After the war my father started a Marble, Tile & Terrazzo business in Miami, Fl., later relocating it to Winter Park, Florida., where

Angela worked in his office for approximately 25 -30 years retiring to help raise grandchildren Lindsay Bazzo daughter of son John Bazzo and Richie and later Annemarie Bazzo, children of Son Richard Bazzo. In later years she became the caregiver for Albert as his health began to fail and looked after him at home until the day of his death at the age of 86. As Angela's own health began to fail she moved into an Assisted Living Facility in Orange City where she remained until her death on Sunday, September 19th, 2014.

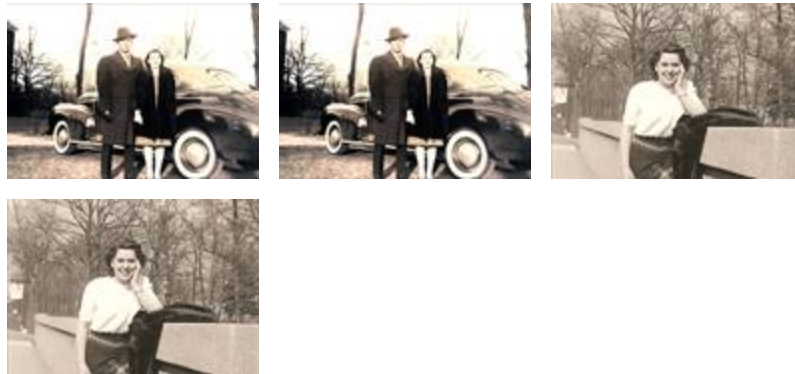
