Domino passed unexpectedly onto his eternal rest on March 4, 2024 in Apopka, Florida at the age of 61. Domino was born in Seattle, Washington, on August 3, 1962.

Domino embarked on his radio journey near his hometown in Fort Collins, Colorado, starting with positions at a local station before transitioning to overnight shifts at a station in Fargo, North Dakota. Subsequently, he navigated through various roles in Arkansas, New York, Georgia, California, Minnesota, Oklahoma, and Texas. Domino touched the lives of many with his warmth, wit, and passion for broadcasting. He joined WOCL in February 2010, shortly after PD Rick Stacy, with whom he had collaborated at Power 99/Atlanta in the mid-1980s. His extensive experience included hosting nights at KIIS-FM/Los Angeles in the mid-1990s and KHKS/Dallas from 1996 to 2003, along with roles at WPLJ/New York and KGGI/Riverside, among others.

A very dedicated father and esteemed radio personality, Domino poured his heart and soul into nurturing and guiding his beloved daughter Zoe, instilling in her values of love, kindness, and resilience. His unwavering support and boundless love will forever remain in the hearts of his family.

In his illustrious career as a radio personality, Domino captivated audiences with his magnetic presence and genuine connection. Whether through entertaining banter, insightful commentary, or heartfelt stories, he left an indelible mark on the airwaves and in the hearts of listeners.

Beyond his professional achievements, Domino was known for his generosity, humor, and unwavering commitment to making a positive impact on those around him. His legacy of kindness and compassion will continue to inspire all who had the privilege of knowing him. Though Domino may no longer grace the airwaves, his spirit will forever resonate in the memories and lives of those he touched.
