Arturo Allers, Jr; Papo or Al to his family and closest friends, passed away at the age of 87 in his sleep on Wednesday morning, April 7, 2022 at his home in Kissimmee, Florida.

Papo was born in Ponce, Puerto Rico on September 2, 1934 where he grew up and graduated from Ponce Senior High School on May 30, 1952 and joined the United States Air Force. During his time in the service, he married the love of his life Ana Maria Allers. They traveled to many countries such as Germany, Paris, and Spain, to name a few.
