Betty Christmas Baxter, a resident of Belle Isle, Florida went to her eternal home in Heaven on Friday afternoon September 9th, 2022. She was born August 13, 1932 in Moultrie, Georgia and is the eldest of seven children of Willie Lee and Ola Mae Christmas. She emigrated from Georgia to Central Florida in the early 1960's and became the provider/advisor of her extended family.
