Becky Murray, age 74, of Orlando, Florida passed away May 17, 2014. Becky was born on June 23, 1939 in Beaufort, South Carolina. She was a realtor. Becky is survived by her Husband, Wendel Murray; Sons, Jim Murray, Brian Murray; Daughter, Wendy McKenna; Brother, Butch Kears; and 3 Grandchildren.
