Bobbie Moorhead Henry, 89, from Winter Park, FL, passed away on November 14, 2018 in Orlando, FL, after a stroke. Bobbie was born on August 6, 1929, in Ocala, FL. Her parents were James Robert Moorhead and Sarah Howard Moorhead. After attending Florida State University for two years where she was in Alpha Gamma Delta sorority, she graduated from the University of Florida in 1951 with a major in Fine Arts. In 1952 she married William O. E. Henry and they moved to Bartow, FL when he joined the law firm that became Holland & Knight.

Bobbie was the co-leader of Girl Scout Troop 43 for 14 years. In Bartow, she was a member of Asbury Methodist Church. In the '80s, Bobbie moved to Orlando, FL, where she joined First Presbyterian Church of Orlando.
