Every morning before school, she propped the door open and made sure all of the kids came into her room to say “goodbye” to her, and she always wished them a good day. If one of them forgot, with oxygen tubes and very little breath to use, she would do her best to yell for them to come and give her a good morning send off.

Genia had a quiet but strong love. If she loved you, you knew it but not because she said it. She was a fierce 5’2” woman who had a difficult time taking “No” for an answer. Even in situations that didn’t benefit her, she wanted her way. To her, the word “No” was just a signal to try again from a different perspective. She needed a lung transplant desperately, and after each rejection from multiple hospitals, of getting on the transplant list, she would try another. At the very last minute, she was accepted, but it was a bit too late. Ultimately, she was fighting a losing battle and complications from her

illness took her away on Friday, February 23rd.

Genia is also survived by her mother, Doris Paige, siblings Rennie Tarver, Debi Tarver, Cecelia McGill, Valerie Chambers, and Tammy Doleman. She had a special place in her heart for Kiti, whom she loved like her own son. She will be deeply missed and the world will never be the same, now that she's not in it.

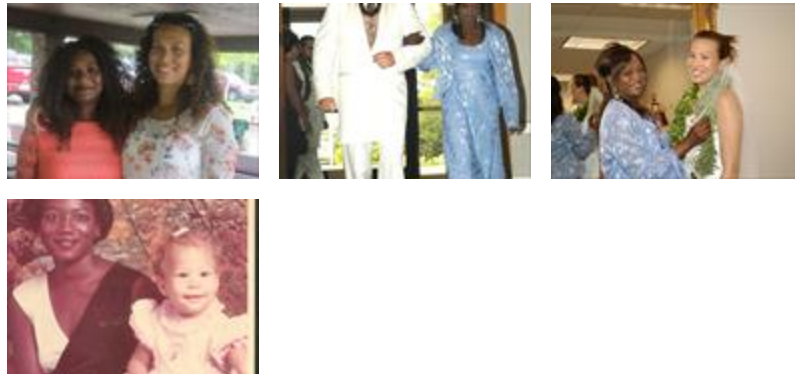
