Brandon lost many close friends in the Pulse Night Club tragedy and participated in many fundraising events. In his personal life his love of music drove his career ambition to be a professional DJ.

An only child, Brandon is survived by his father, Bruce. He leaves behind

numerous loving relatives and friends. Dear to his heart were his friends, he treasured those friendships. No matter where the paths of life took you, you were a friend for life. A caring heart, he would help you to the best of his ability, be it something to eat or a place to stay. A shrieking laugh, a loving hug, or words of support, if you were his friend, he had your back.

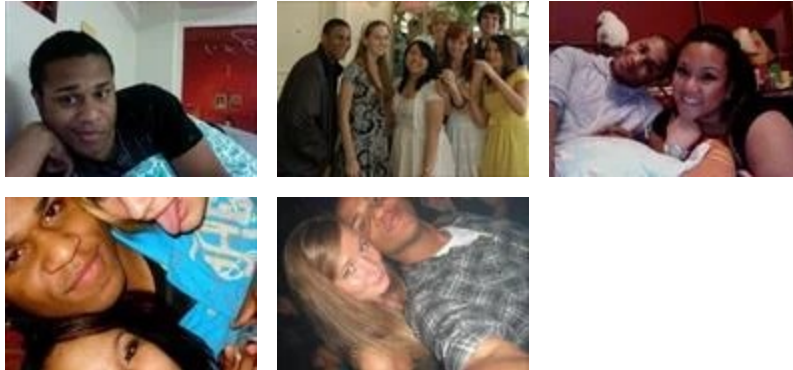

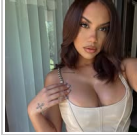

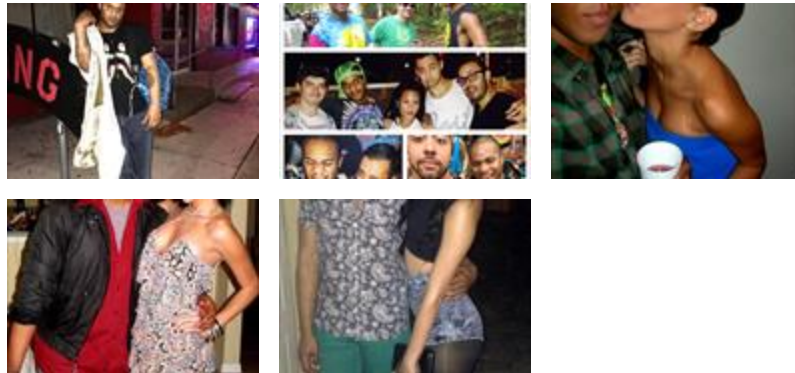
