Carol W. Patterson passed away at home in Orlando, Florida on October 10, 2021 at the age of 89. Born in Pensacola, Florida on February 28, 1932, Carol grew up in Orlando with her parents Robert L. and Ecenia R. Williams and her brother Robert L. Williams, Jr. Carol attend Delaney Elementary, Cherokee Junior High, Orlando High School, where she made friendships that she maintained for the rest of her life.

After graduating from high school in 1949, Carol attend Florida State University where she pledged Delta Delta Delta (Tri Delta). Carol left FSU when she married U.S. Air Force officer George K.
