February 12, 1947 - May 17, 2026

It is with deep love and sadness that we announce the passing of Dianilda Acevedo, born February 12, 1947 in Manati, PR, passed away on May 17, 2026, in Orlando at the age of 79.

Though she was an only child, Dianilda built a beautiful and loving family that became the center of her world. She is survived by her four children: Oscar David Acevedo, Dianilda Enid Rosario, Jennifer Acevedo, and Robert Acevedo; 16 grandchildren; 25 great-grandchildren; and her beloved dog, Mochito, who brought her endless comfort and companionship.

She dedicated much of her life to helping others through volunteer work, serving faithfully for 16 years at New Bethany Ministries in Bethlehem, PA. She will be remembered for her humor, kindness, patience, understanding, and unconditional love for others. Dianilda was non-judgmental, accepting, forgiving, and dependable — the kind of person who made everyone feel welcomed and valued. Her caring heart and gentle presence touched countless lives, and her memory will continue to live on through the family and

friends who loved her dearly.

Her legacy is one of compassion, service, faith, and love. She will be deeply missed and forever remembered. Dianilda's impact on her family and community will echo for generations.
