Elizabeth "Betty" Van Trump died Monday morning, 4/11/16 as a result of terminal pancreatic cancer. She was 75 years old. Betty was born June 23rd, 1940 to Myron E. and Victoria C. Morson. She was the oldest of five children, all of whom were born and raised in Red Bank, New Jersey.

Upon marrying in February 1965 at St. James Catholic Church in Red Bank, Betty and her husband relocated to his hometown of Orlando, Florida.
