



## Elsa Naomi Osborne

May 24, 1936 - October 5, 2021

Elsa Naomi Osborne, 85, of Orlando, Florida, formally from the Bronx, New York, passed away on October 5, 2021 with her family by her side.

She was born to the late Luis and Rosario Aguirre, on May 24, 1936 in Quito, Ecuador. In September of 1959, she and her family relocated to New York. Not knowing any English, she enrolled in night school at Roosevelt High School in the Bronx and within 2 years became an American citizen.

She married Carlton J. Osborne in 1967 and they lived together in the Bronx for 53 years before relocating to Orlando. Elsa is survived by her husband of 54 years, Carlton J. Osborne and her two daughters: Elise Osborne of New York and Sonja Osborne-Figueroa of Orlando. She is also survived by her two grandsons, Aiden and Austin.

Elsa was an accomplished business owner of a successful neighborhood beauty salon for 41 years. However, family was always her main priority and she became the matriarch that helped keep the family together once her mother passed away. Elsa was an amazing self-taught “chef” and many people will remember how she brought family and friends together through her love of cooking. She passed on the appreciation of cooking and instilled the importance of family to her daughters.
