Eva R. Barbatis, 85, a longtime resident of Orlando, FL, passed away Thursday, October 8, 2015. Eva is survived by her sister Ada Modrow, her son Peter Barbatis, her only granddaughter Melissa Barbatis, and her three nephews David Modrow, Omar Reyes, and Osmil Reyes.

Born in Mariano, Cuba, Eva immigrated to the United States in 1955. Initially residing in New York City, she moved to Orlando in 1974 and worked for the Walt Disney World Company for 20 years.

A giver at heart, she cared for all those with whom she came in contact, helping in particular the elderly and recently arrived immigrants. She strove to make a difference and showed compassion for the disenfranchised and marginalized.
