Frank W. K. Yee, beloved husband, father, and grandfather, passed onto his eternal rest on April 21, 2024 at age 85, in Orlando, FL.

Frank will be remembered by his wife, Eileen Yee; his daughter Miriam and her family, including Kiyō, Michael and Anna Marukuni; his daughter Elizabeth and her family, Bryan, Eli, and Ryu Boleyn; and his son, Andrew Yee.

He is preceded in death by his father Shew Hong Yee, his mother Wai Fong Yee, and his oldest son Brynner Yee.

Frank was born on October 12, 1938 in mainland China. He moved to Hong Kong with his mother when he was young, where he finished his schooling and then taught at a Christian private school for some time. He later immigrated to the United States, as did his mother and his wife, and was reunited with his father.

The funeral service will be held on May 7th, 2024 at 10:30am, and will be preceded by a short time to say goodbye at 10am. Immediately after the funeral, there will be a committal at the cemetery. Once it got to midair, it rocked like a yo-yo. To cut a long story short, the plane finally arrived at the destination after stops in Denver and Colorado Springs. Frank and Eileen met me at the airport and they were there to look at a business potential. Yet they took time to show me around. That was the first and only time I saw huge balls of tumbling weeds rolling along the road sides as shown in cowboy movies. The kind elderly gentleman told me about his life story. During his early years, he should have provided services to customers on campus so much and so often that the only school he knew in the US was Harvard. Wow, it wasn't bad at all for he knew the best, arguably in the world. Through their extensive family network and connections, Peter worked for several Chinese restaurants there. It was a fruitful summer both in terms of income and cultural orientation to work and living on the eastern seaboard of the US.
