



## George T. Nichols

George Truman Nichols passed peacefully in his home early in the morning of July 3, 2024, surrounded in love by his wife of 63 years, Patricia Repass Nichols, and supported by Cornerstone Hospice.

Born in Oregon, and raised in Wyoming, after graduating from the University of Wyoming, Mr. Nichols served this country as an officer of the United States Air Force for 20 years in several states and countries before retiring to Orlando, FL in 1975.
