



## Harry "Bud" Lamar Ellis

June 26, 1931 - January 21, 2018

Harry "Bud" Lamar Ellis died in Orlando, FL on January 21, 2018 due to complications related to liver and pancreatic cancer. He was 86.

Harry Ellis was born on June 26, 1931 in Newport, Vermont to his parents, Julia and William Ellis. He graduated from Syracuse University with a Masters degree in Business Administration. Harry served in the U.S. Army at Fort Benning from 1954-1956 as an aerial photographer before being honorably discharged. After marrying, Harry and his wife, Joan Marie LaRose, moved to South Florida where Harry worked as a pharmaceutical rep, owned two pharmacies and Boca Raton Surgical Supply before retiring in 1995.

Whether world traveling, helicopter flying, boating, fishing, building a house, talking politics, reminiscing about his childhood, playing with his dog Guido, researching the stock market, or spending time with his family and friends, Harry enjoyed his many days and adventures.
