Harry Peter Lambert, 97, died Tuesday, 03/29 at home. Born in Scranton, PA, he served in the 45th Infantry Div. of the Army during World War II and was in Munich, Germany when the war ended which he received the Bronze Star Medal. After the war, Harry returned to Scranton and worked as a truck driver for Miller Casket Co. Harry then married Geneva Duboski. He later worked as a driver/manager for Butler Casket Co. and after many years of working there, he took a job with Stephanie Fashions until retirement. After retirement, Harry and Geneva enjoyed traveling throughout the U.S. to visit family and friends. In the last year of his life, he moved to Orlando, Florida with his wife to be closer to family. Harry was an avid fan of Penn State Nittany Lions football and Nascar. He enjoyed walking Lake Scranton and Steamtown Mall with his friends. He also enjoyed fishing at Thousand Islands in Canada. Harry could often be found helping family and friends with their home projects. He is survived by wife, Geneva of 66 years of marriage, his son Harry Alan (Jeanne), grandsons Alan (Brooke), Kevin (Christina) and great granddaughter, Maggie.
