Jackie Ebrahimoff, age 66 of Orlando, Florida passed away on November 28, 2015. Jackie was born on October 1, 1949 in Germany. Jackie was a Clydesdale Horse Handler at Sea World. Jackie is survived by; son, Christopher P. Ebrahimoff and his father Arthur Ebrahimoff; partner in life, Paul Marr; brothers, Benjamin S. Hanson, III (Jan), Richard G. Hanson (Teresa), Rob Hanson (Allison). Jacqueline Margit Ebrahimoff, better known to family and friends, as “Jackie,” passed away on November 28, 2015.

Born in Neustadt an der Waldnaab, Germany on October 1, 1949, she was the first of four children to Col. Benjamin Shaw Hanson Jr. and Antonie H. Stojanski. The self-professed “army brat” later traveled with her parents, and oldest brother throughout Europe, the United States and even the Eastern Pacific as part of her childhood. What she would routinely consider some of the best times of her life, these years also formed the basis of one of the closest brother/sister relationships one could imagine.

Later, as Jackie grew, she would develop an immense love for animals -- especially horses! And that love set the foundation for the rest of her life. As a young girl she would eventually receive the greatest gift she could ever have imagined – her own horse “Dallas.”

Jackie would begin to ride Hunters and Jumpers from that point on her entire

life. In later years she taught riding classes, worked with the Orange County Sheriff's Office Mounted Unit, and had her career pinnacle as a part of the Anheuser-Busch Clydesdale Team during their ownership of SeaWorld Parks and Entertainment.

Most importantly however, Jackie always stressed her love for family and friends, and was routinely considered one of the happiest people anyone could meet.

As Jackie lived, she always found a way to look on the bright side, and set an example of how to enjoy life that many wish they could emulate. Though she had many roles in life, her proudest were those of a daughter, a sister, a friend, a teacher, and most importantly – a mother.

She loved spending time with friends, traveling to her beloved Virginia, and had a wonderful smile that could light up a room.

She will truly be missed by all.

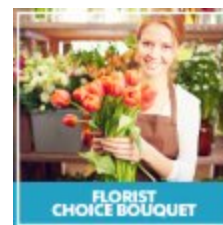
