Jameil Crameron McWhorter "J-Mac", (38), born in Orlando, Florida, passed away April 30, 2014.

Jameil McWhorter is a partner at the Law Firm of Lowndes, Drosdick, Doster, Kantor & Reed, P.A. and is a Midnight Basketball of Florida alumnus. He was a standout on the University of Central Florida football team where he was voted one of the defensive team captains. He then attended law school at the University of Florida, has been recognized by "Who's Who of America" among student athletes from 1993-1997, and was former Law Clerk for famed Civil Trial Attorney, Willie E. Gary. McWhorter is a partner in the Litigation practice, focusing on sports and entertainment law, commercial litigation and family and marital law. In the sports law arena, Jameil has handled contract disputes and family law cases involving athletes in the National Basketball Association, national Football League and Major League Baseball. He has also represented past and current professional athletes in various business capacities.

Arthur Jackson served as a coach and mentor to McWhorter who participated in Midnight Basketball. Mr. Jackson encouraged McWhorter to be the best he could be and focus on his education.

McWhorter is being inducted as a Midnight Basketball Great as he has

brought recognition and prominence to the Program and himself through outstanding athletic achievements as a collegiate student-athlete, and has distinguished himself as exceptional in his chosen field of law.

McWhorter is a member of the Orange County Bar Association, The Florida Bar, The National Bar Association and the American Bar Association. He also serves on the Orlando advisory board for the United Negro College Fund and on the Lake Nona YMCA board of directors.

McWhorter "J-Mac" is survived by his mother Phyllis A. McWhorter-Barker, his father Carl Watts, his sister Danielle Gentry, and his niece Breezae Rainey.
