James Bee Boyette, born in Tampa, FL on 11/18/1927 to William and Dessie Boyette has lived a most remarkable life. Leaving behind son Billie, Rickey and Darrell, grandkids Heather, Rickey Jr., Bethany and Douglas and great grandkids Alice and Chance. He is now with his wife Marie, sons Larry and Douglas and daughter Sandy.

Jim served his country for 35 years in the Navy, retiring as LT Commander in May 1980. While in the Navy, he played baseball on the Navy All Star Team for 15 years. He likes to tell the story that he processed Senator John McCain's pay when he was released from a POW camp back to Jacksonville, FL.

While in Hawaii serving in the Navy still, Jim was part of a country western band Louisiana Drifters, the number one band in Hawaii at the time. He played the bass fiddle, steel guitar, bass guitar which later prepared him to play his grand-daughter's house band for you are my sunshine.

Jim Boyette is a true pioneer in the sport of barefoot water skiing. He learned to barefoot in 1973 at the age of 45, when very little was known of the sport. He became a member of the Australian Barefoot Water Ski Club, skiing in the Australian Masters Tournament. He has competed in every national tournament starting in 1978, winning 70+ championships, and setting 30 national records. He is the WORLDS oldest barefoot water skier. He has featured in many local news segments, both on TV and in print as well as national articles in major magazines.

Through all of his accomplishments, Jim battled Melanoma, Non-Hodgins Lymphoma, bouts of AFIB and Charcot-Marie-Tooth Neuropathy Disorder. He generously gave to charity on a regular basis, cared for friends and family becoming a mentor and hero for so many people.

Jim, Dad, Grandpa, Great p-pa, will be missed by his family, friends and community. Truly a hero on so many levels. We can all say that we leave better to have known and loved him.
