



Joanna Christine Jara

October 23, 1996 - November 26, 2019

It is with a broken heart that we share Joanna Jara, 23, passed away at sunrise November 26, 2019 in Orlando, Florida, after a five-year battle with Osteosarcoma. Joanna was born in Miami, Florida, October 23, 1996 and attended elementary school at Montessori in Hammond, Indiana, middle school Holy Name of Jesus, Indialantic, Florida, and high school Holy Trinity Episcopal Academy, Melbourne, Florida. She was diagnosed with osteosarcoma towards the end of her junior year March 2014, and regardless of the need of a major surgery at Moffitt Cancer Center in Tampa, Florida, as well as 9 months of inpatient chemotherapy at Arnold Palmer Hospital, Orlando, Florida, she was able to complete her senior year and was accepted to University of Miami, School of Communications August 2015 where she graduated recently with a Bachelor degree. Sadly, the osteosarcoma returned twice, the last time in March 2019 with such a severe pain and suffering, that will not end until she finally rested in peace. She faced every trial bravely and at age twenty-three she had accomplished so much and overcome so many difficulties with grace and strength. She had many plans and we have no doubt she would have continued to excel at life if it had not been for our inability as society to provide her and others with treatments and cure to cancerous disease. She passed surrounded by the love of her family, sisters Kathy and Andrea, and parents, Lili and Cesar, as well as friends, represented physically at her bedside by Joey Rain.

There are no words to properly describe the feelings that accompany this unfair and devastating outcome.

However, our family is comforted by Joanna's everlasting presence and by the message: to not be overcome by sadness and to continue to live life fully. Please, continue to honor her in any way you can and live your life inspired by her bravery and grit.

We hope that you join us in honoring Joanna by attending her Celebration of Life Ceremony, which will be held Saturday November 30th. A Funeral Mass will be celebrated at 9:00 AM followed by a reception at 10:00 AM in the church Life Center at St. James Cathedral, 215 N Orange Ave, Orlando, FL 32801.

“ I never knew exactly what Joanna’s battles were. She never complained about anything to me and just focused on the impossible task of rebuilding, reprogramming and re-doing just about everything with WVUM.. She was incredibly passionate and dedicated and always had a great sense of humor.

I had the pleasure of being the technical consultant at WVUM with an amazing group of students and Joanna was at the head of the pack. 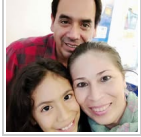
