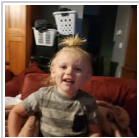
“ John will be missed, here at HW Davis Construction. He always had a smile on his face and brightened my day when he stopped by the office.

*My thoughts and prayers are with those young children (as well as the entire family) who do not and may never, understand why this happened.*

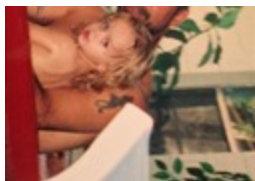
