



Jose Enrique Perezcassar M.D.

January 28, 1950 - April 23, 2026

Dr. Jose Enrique Perezcassar was born on January 28, 1950 in Managua, Nicaragua, and passed away peacefully at home in his sleep on April 23, 2026, at the age of 76.

He was preceded in death by his parents, María Ofelia and Marcelino Perezcassar, his brothers Marcelino Jr. and Modesto, and his sister Mayling; he is survived by his sister Linda and his brother Luis Edwardo.

He married Liz Alicia Saenz on May 16, 1976, in Rivas, Nicaragua, with whom he had four children. He was a devoted husband, a caring father, a loving grandfather, a skilled physician, and a good friend to those who knew him.

As a physician, he earned his medical degree from the Universidad Nacional Autónoma de Nicaragua, completed his OB/GYN residency at Antonio Lenin Fonseca Hospital in Managua, and following the family's emigration to the U.S. in 1982, went on to complete his Family Practice residency at Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, Texas, a Fellowship in Academic Medicine in Waco, Texas, and Board Certification by the American Board of Family Practice — holding medical licenses in Washington, Florida, and Texas.

In addition to teaching and training physicians, he practiced medicine in hospitals across the U.S. and established many private practice clinics

throughout his career, with the intent to provide medical care for the uninsured, the underinsured and immigrant communities.

An autodidact, his passions included playing instruments, repairing classic cars, studying world languages, and making friends anywhere he went. He was a devoted Catholic and always willing to provide counsel and a Bible verse for any of life's ethical dilemmas. He valued self-reliance and the well-being of his family.

He is survived by his devoted wife Liz, with nearly 50 years of marriage, two daughters, two sons, seven grandchildren, and two siblings.

A funeral mass will be held in his honor at Holy Family Catholic Church in Orlando, FL on June 12, 2026 at 11am.
