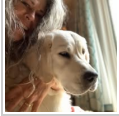
My father used to tell us this story when we were kids. The lil monkey story is one of my fondest childhood memories.

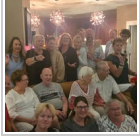

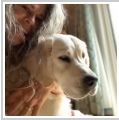
