Taft, FL — Julian Dame Gresham, 81, died Thursday, February 13, 2016 suddenly of unnatural causes at his home in Taft.

Mr. Gresham leaves his wife, Naomi Gresham; his daughters Tessie Gresham & Teresa Gresham Phillips (spouse Danny Phillips); Granddaughter Penny Lynette Phillips and is preceded in death by his parents, Claude & Maude Gresham and his Grandson Danny Phillips, Jr.
