Julie Doherty Petosa, 58, of Orlando, passed away July 29th after a 16-year battle with cancer. Her family was by her side at the University of Washington Medical Center when she drifted into the arms of the Lord.

She was born to Edward Doherty and Wilda Karnes Doherty in Jackson, Michigan, on January 19, 1958. Julie was a long time resident of Staten Island, New York, before moving to Orlando with her husband in 2003.

Julie's deep faith kept her very involved at her church, St. John Vianney. She traveled with the church to the Holy Land in October 2015.
