Keith S. Crowe, age 57, peacefully passed away on December 28, 2024 due to complications resulting from a brain aneurysm. Raised in Park Forest, Illinois, the son of Michael and Babette (Wiscons) Crowe. Keith was the second of four sons.

Keith attended the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign - College of Business. Upon graduation, he worked at Price Waterhouse and then Premark International, where he met his wife, Anne, of 29 years. After getting married, Keith and Anne moved to Orlando, Florida to work for Tupperware Brands Corporation. Keith worked for Tupperware for more than 28 years, lastly acting as their VP and Treasurer. In 2009, he graduated top in his class from the Crummer Graduate School of Business.

Keith and Anne raised two sons. Keith enjoyed being heavily involved in their lives, often coaching their various childhood sports, as well as acting as their School Board President for a number of years. He was always there to support and guide his sons, and was very proud of the men they have become.

Keith was a very generous man, sharing his time and talents without hesitation. Besides the love for his wife and sons, he enjoyed cheering on the Fighting Illini, playing golf, and getting together with friends, where he often

stole the show with his charismatic personality, great sense of humor, and big smile.

Keith is survived by his father, Michael, his brothers, Kevin, Kerry (Jeanette), and Kelly (Sara), his wife, Anne, and two sons, Phillip and David.
