Kevin C. Young was born on September 16, 1973 to parents Larry Young and Deborah Spruill-Frazier in Norfolk, VA. He attended Great Bridge High School PTSA and graduated from ECPI Virginia Beach with a degree in computer. He transitioned to his heavenly homecoming on July 17, 2021.

Kevin was a devoted fan of the Tampa Bay Buccaneers. With a love for football, came a love for basketball, bowling, and a good game of spades. He enjoyed old school music, reflective moments at the beach, house gatherings, and movies.

Among his accomplishments was the creation of Grown Folks Radio Worldwide. His voice was heard globally as he shared his love for the gospel and God's redemptive power. As a host of Everyday Talk with Carmen & Kevin, he enjoyed sharing his heart about his own struggles with full transparency. As a certified Master Life Coach, he shared knowledge and tools on the platform to impart wisdom to help others (especially men) on how to change the mindset on their journey. He evangelized on air, ministered privately, mentored publicly, and pastored all that came across his path. His "YES" to ministry led him through ministry leadership training on the path to ordination.

Kevin is survived by his beloved, Carmen; his son, Jaylen; his brothers and

sister, Carl, Eric, and Erica; his parents, Larry Young and Deborah Spruill-Frazier; and countless family members and friends that loved him deeply. He will be greatly missed!

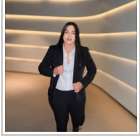

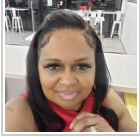

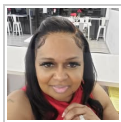
