April 14, 1935 - September 24, 2017

Mrs. Latchmin Goolcharan passed away on Sunday, September 24, 2017 at the age of 82.

Latchmin was the ninth of thirteen children born to parents Bhagwandeem and Basdiya Ramgoolie on April 14, 1935 in Curepe, Trinidad.

After spending her early years growing up in Curepe she eventually moved to Maraval where she was married to her husband Victor Goolcharan and together they had nine children.

Latchmin was very compassionate and sociable as well as a dedicated mother, wife, sister, and friend. She worked at Indian High Commissioner Embassy for 40 years and enjoyed every minute of it.

Latchmin had a big heart and was loved by everyone that knew her and she was always willing to lend a helping hand to anyone in need. She loved to dance, sing, cook and throw parties and loved to celebrate the holidays especially Birthdays, Christmas, and Divali. Latchmin was a very spiritual person and was a devoted Hindu but also had Christian beliefs.

She was adored by all her grandchildren and took care of each one of them by telling them stories, making food especially roti, taking them to the park and to school and spending quality time with all of them. Her famous quote was "Beat your books" because she always put an emphasis on the

importance of education.

Our hearts are broken and you will be truly missed by all of us. We know you are at peace and with God until we meet again.

She is preceded in death by her parents, son: Robert Goolcharan, husband: Victor Goolcharan, and daughter: Sharon Goolcharan George. Latchmin is survived by her sons: Albert, Randolph "Randy" (Karen), David, and Anthony Goolcharan ; daughters: AnnMarie Pitysingh (Andy), Natasha Dharmaratnam (Rohan) and Crystal Goolcharan.
