Lisa Marie Palata, 56, of Orlando, Florida, passed away on August 17, 2025. She was born on September 6, 1968, in Kansas City, Missouri, to Helen Lee Stewart Dunham and Thomas William Becker.

Lisa grew up in Orlando and graduated from Colonial High School. She began her career in the hospitality industry and, through dedication and hard work, rose into management and later became an executive leader with IHG Hotels & Resorts. This past April, she proudly celebrated 25 years with IHG, a milestone that reflected her commitment, leadership, and love for her career.

She was preceded in death by her parents and her first husband, Atiae Palata, with whom she had three children: Kurtis (Ashley), A.J. (partner Tiane), and Kennedy (Chandler). She is survived by her loving husband, Tigi Purcell; her children; and her sister, Melanie Becker.

Lisa loved to travel and never passed up the chance to enjoy a nice glass of wine. That shared passion with her friends brought laughter, connection, and countless cherished memories, moments that reflected her joy for life and the way she found meaning in being with others.

Lisa had a gift for making her home a place of comfort, where everyone felt welcome. Her warmth, generosity, and vibrant personality touched many lives, and her memory will live on in the hearts of all who knew her. 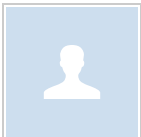

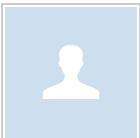
