Lola Mae “Faye” Saffold was born on April 26, 1952 in Dothan, Alabama. She moved to Florida at an early age. She was educated in the Public School system in Apopka, FL moved to New York to attend Corning University in New York. She later attended Valencia Community College where she studied Nursing. In 1996 she was married to Gabriel Aisevbonaye. Lola worked in the medical field and was most recently a Certified Nursing Assistant at Dru’s Place Adult Family Care Home. Lola was also a regular and long time community volunteer. She volunteered her time at the Hope and Help Center, Orange County Healthy Start Coalition (Saves our Babies Program), the Frontline Outreach Center, Farm Workers Association of Florida, The Birth Place, Creating Beauty Chair Covers and Accessories, Women Helping Woman, Orange County Health Department, 31 Ways Foundation, and most recently, The Center for the Multicultural and Wellness and Prevention Center as a community outreach worker. Her volunteer activities included assisting with health screenings such as HIV and Hepatitis C testing, and she was known for her visibility in the community providing outreach services to many. She was passionate about spreading the word about health. The community knew her as “Mama Lola” and she was always willing to lend her time to help

others.

Lola was a long time member of The Full Deliverance Church; later renamed The Faith Center International. Lola later began regularly attending The Grace Bible Church within the last two years.

Lola was a loving mother, sister, aunt and grandmother to her family. She was always present and cheering on her family at every one of their events and milestones. She was preceded in death by her parents, Albert and Hattie Mae Saffold, and her older brother Charles Saffold. Survived by her children; Helen Deboles, Tammy Barkley (Larry), April Johnson of Orlando FL, and Anthony Barkley (Latresea) of Deland, FL; her sisters and brothers, Richard Saffold (Clara), Maline Williams (Oscar), and Bernice Fitzgerald of Apopka, FL. 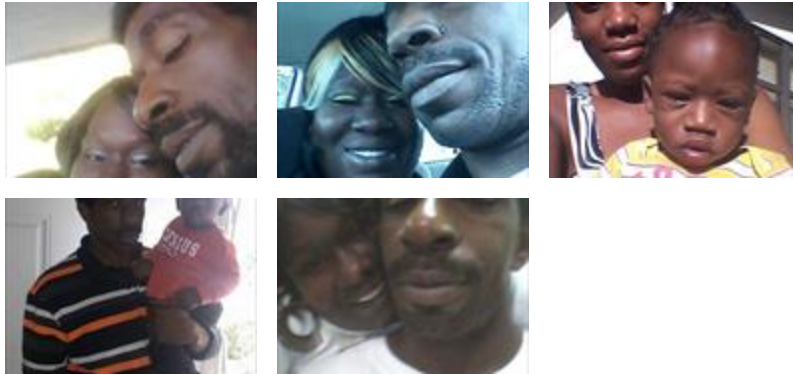
