



Long Van Vo

March 2, 1946 - September 7, 2019

Long Van Vo passed away at the Orlando Regional Medical Center in Orlando Florida, on the seventh day of September, 2019 at the age of 73.

Long was born in My Tho, Vietnam on the second day of March, 1946. He grew up in Saigon as the son of a police commissioner and is a veteran of the Vietnam War. There, he served as a helicopter pilot for the South Vietnamese Airforce and served his country honorably fighting for democracy and freedom. He was instrumental in providing protection to soldiers both on the ground and in the air. His helicopter was shot down multiple times and he was fortunate to survive each event. After the Vietnam War ended, he was held in a communist “reeducation camp” for several years and survived to eventually reunite with his wife and daughter in America in 1981.

Upon arriving in Wales, Pennsylvania in 1983, Long continued his education where he received his certification to become an electronic technician. In 1989, with the arrival of his mother-in-law, Long Vo moved with his family to Orlando, Florida. His work ethic gave him the endurance to work two full time jobs until retirement.

Long was an avid tennis player and he enjoyed the company of his fellow veteran peers. At home, Long could be found tending to his garden where he enjoyed sharing his plants, fruits, and vegetables with the Orlando community.

Long Van Vo is survived by the mother of his children, Diep Vo, the youngest son, Alexander Vo and eldest daughter Thanh Vo, two grandchildren, Truong An Nguyen and Truong Loc Nguyen (ages 8 and 6). He also has siblings in Vietnam, France, and Australia. They are Vo Thi Hoang Lan (sister), Vo Hoang Minh (brother), Vo Hoang Mẫn (brother), Vo Kim Cúc (sister), Vo Hoang Khanh (brother), and Vo Kim Phuong (sister).

Funeral services will be held at the Phap Vu Buddhist Temple on the ninth day of September, 2019, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
