Lorenza “Laurie” Amato, age 90, of Orlando, Florida, went to meet our Lord on December 31, 2025, surrounded by her family and a dear friend Hilda. Fifty years to the date her father passed.

Laurie was born on June 7, 1935, in Beloit, Wisconsin. She was a devoted mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother who loved her family deeply. Her greatest joy in life was her children. She guided them with love, strength, and patience, helping shape them into the people they are today. She also cherished every moment spent with her granddaughters, watching them grow into kind, generous women.
