Lorraine M. Conte passed away peacefully at Hospice of the Comforter in Altamonte Springs, Florida on December 26, 2016, at the age of 87. Lorraine was born in Chicago, IL on April 11, 1929 to Ida and Anthony Panozzo in the Roseland section of Chicago. As a teenager, she met Tony Conte, the man who would become the true love of her life. Lorraine and Tony married on June 24, 1950 thus beginning a marriage that would last for 51 years until Tony's death in 2001. It was clear to anyone who knew them or who saw them together that Lorraine and Tony shared a deep and abiding love for each other and for their family. They were soulmates and life companions. Lorraine and Tony raised four sons on the south side of Chicago, and would later move to Phoenix, AZ, Atlanta, GA, and finally to Orlando, FL.

She was known to play a mean game of softball or wiffle ball with her grandchildren or any of the other neighborhood kids who would visit her and for taking her dogs on long walks through her neighborhood. She was an avid Chicago Cubs fan throughout her life and would watch as many Cubs games on television as she possibly could. While robbed of her memory near the end of her life due to Alzheimer's disease, there is no doubt that Lorraine was overjoyed by the Cubs winning the 2016 World Series, a lifelong dream of hers. She was dedicated to her family and many friends who loved her and who will miss her and her infectious smile and laughter dearly.


