Luis Alberto Garcia del Busto, 74 passed away peacefully on August 1st, 2023 due to complications from Diabetes and Coronary Heart Disease.

Luis was born November 16th, 1948 in Camaguey, Cuba. He immigrated to the United States on April 9th, 1962 and became a naturalized United States Citizen.

Penny, he returned to Disney and continued his career in several departments such as Ride & Show Animation,

Tree Fab, Decorating, Parades, Christmas, Entertainment Support, Scenic Services. Prior to retirement he was the Manager of the Character Head Department with over 100 Cast Members. He was part of the team that went to Italy to bring back the Wonder Cruise Ship to the U.S. He loved what he did.

Luis met and married his wife at EPCOT during a July 4th Fireworks Show. It was a life long love and was truly devoted to her for the rest of his life.

Luis was a devoted Catholic and parishioner at the Holy Family Catholic Church. He was a joyful, kind man and always smiling and spreading good cheer. He never met a person he did not like, there were no strangers.

Luis was very proud of his Cuban Heritage, he love his Cuban music and dancing, enjoyed watching boxing and working out was his past time. He loved to have fun,
