



Luis Ramos Rivera

January 8, 1920 - November 23, 2013

Master Sergeant Luis Ramos Rivera, 93, of Puerto Nuevo, Puerto Rico passed away on November 23, 2013.

Sergeant Ramos was born on January 8, 1920 in Cayey, Puerto Rico to Pedro Ramos and Maria Rivera. He wed Frances Vazquez on December 5, 1941.

He joined the US Army at the age of 20 and served with distinction in WWII. Sergeant Ramos earned numerous commendations, including three bronze stars for his service in North Africa, France and Central Europe. After the war, he re-enlisted in the Army and was stationed at Fort Buchanan until departing for the Korean conflict in 1951. Sergeant Ramos saw heavy combat in Korea and was awarded another bronze star, with oak leaf cluster, for meritorious service. He retired from the Army in 1960 after 20 years of service.

He is survived by his son, Luis A. Ramos and daughter in law Lillian of Orlando, FL; his grandson Luis D. Ramos and his granddaughter in law Ronilynn of Suwanee, GA; his granddaughter Lily Ramos of Orlando, FL; his sister Carmen Gott of NJ; and three great grandchildren: Anthony, Victoria and Christina.

He was predeceased by his wife Frances Vazquez and his daughter Alma Milagros Ramos.

Visitation will be held Tuesday November 26th, from 6-9 p.m. at A Community Funeral Home and Sunset Cremation and will be followed by funeral services at 7 p.m.
