Lynn Jones, 52 of Orlando Florida passed away on June 24, 2020. He was a dedicated husband and father as well as a longtime Deputy of the Lake County Sheriff's Office.

His service at the funeral home are being kept private and attendance is being limited to invite only by immediate family members, however, a viewing for the public is being set for Monday, July 13th, from 3- 5 PM, with 35 guests at a time. Please wear a mask. The family is setting up a live stream for the day of the viewing so you can attend remotely...please check back in the coming days for an updated link.

There will also be a memorial service for the public at a church in Lake County. The exact location and date/time are yet to be determined.

On Wednesday June 24,2020 at the blessed age of 52, Lynn Jones transitioned into eternal rest. He was born May 21, 1968 to the late Willie and Gladys Jones in Alexandria Louisiana.

He attended Grambling State and later joined the Army, which is where he found his love and passion for cooking. This passion led him to Morrison's Cafeteria where he became a Head Chef and where he met his wife Felisia. He then later followed another dream of his, which was Law Enforcement. He

became a stand up, law abiding member of the Lake County Sheriff Office and worked his way up to become a Master Deputy and was recently promoted to Corporal. He loved his job and everything that came along with it. He was one day short of a Thirteen year run with the LCSO.

He devoted his life to his family, friends and anyone else that needed assistance, guidance or a helping hand. He was full of knowledge and wisdom, yet understanding and could be very stern when needed to be. He was always there with open arms when you needed him.

Lynn is preceded in death by his parents Willie and Gladys Jones, his brother Joseph and his loving twin sister Lynette Jones.

He leaves to cherish his memory: his loving wife Felisia Jones, whom he was looking forward to celebrating their 11th year Anniversary with in August, three daughters: ShaLynn, Kandance and Jada. One Stepson Ricky, two stepdaughters Tadaisha and Rikeisha, four step grandkids Keonna, Keonndra, Keonnie and De'Angelo. Lynn also had the pleasure of being a stepfather to Sharlece, Arleen and Richard, all of which were from a previous marriage before he became a father of his own three children.
