Marguerite A. Woehrle, 68, of Sebring, FL passed away on November 5, 2015, at Orlando Regional Medical Center, FL, surrounded by the love of her family following a courageous battle against an aggressive lung disease. Marguerite (also fondly known as “Maggie”), was born October 28, 1947 in Berlin New Hampshire, the daughter of Joseph and Beatrice Springer nee Bergeron. She resided in Berlin until graduating with honors from Notre Dame High School earning herself a scholarship to Katherine Gibbs College in New Jersey. Marguerite was employed by Monroe Calculator in Orange, New Jersey where she met her future husband Herbert Woehrle of Scranton, Pennsylvania, marrying on February 4, 1967. Throughout her life Marguerite worked for Robbins Auto Parts, New England Mammography, and Karen’s Covers in the Dover, New Hampshire area. She continued her career with Stryker Biotechnologies, Creative Bio-Molecules, and lastly GTC Biotherapeutics Inc, where she was a Senior Quality Assistant in Framingham Massachusetts. Maggie retired to Sebring FL where she volunteered at Florida Hospital.

Maggie raised six children and family was her primary focus. Nothing made her heart fuller than seeing her children’s happiness and success. Her additional interests included bowling, (how she her met her husband), knitting,

painting, making hand-made gifts for friends and family and flower gardens - especially lilacs and roses. Marguerite was quick-witted, tactful and a force to be reckoned with across a game table. She was a member of Our Lady of the Valley Parish in NJ, St. Mary's Parish in both NH and MA and St. Catherine's parish in Sebring FL.

Marguerite was predeceased by her parents and her sisters Lorraine Vachon of Manchester NH and Pauline McGreevy of Mt. Pocono, PA.
