Marilyn E. Avery passed away after a brief illness in Orlando, Fl. on Dec. 23, 2013. She was born on Oct. 15, 1925 in Nashua, N.H. to Harold and Dora (Wingate) Miner. She was married to Eugene Avery on Oct. 24, 1946 in Antrim, N.H. Marilyn raised six children and frequently moved with them while he was in the Air Force. The family eventually resettled in Antrim where the children attended school; Marilyn worked in the elementary school cafeteria, then at Sylvania in Hillsboro for many years. The family moved to Orlando, Fl in 1967, where she got a job with Hartford Insurance for several years, and then worked for the city of Orlando in the Parking Ticket Division until her retirement. Marilyn moved to Bradenton, Fl after her husband died on June 19, 1997. After several years she moved to Jacksonville and lived with her daughter, Jeanette, for two years. After surviving treatment for cancer, she moved back to Bradenton near her son, Bob. Her final move was to an Independent Facility in Orlando that was central for her children and grandchildren to visit her. Marilyn was predeceased by her husband Eugene, her oldest son Alan, and her sisters Jeanette Rinehart(Marvin) and Shirley McAllister. She is survived by her daughters; Jeanette Avery, Jacksonville, Fl; Nancy Pond (Jerry), Windermere, Fl; and Rosalie Ricketts, N. Miami Bch, Fl; sons Robert Avery (Mary) of Bradenton, Fl. and Joseph Avery, Orlando, Fl. She leaves behind 8 grandchildren and 8 great grandchildren.
