Marion Cooper Van Trump Jr. passed away Sunday, June 17th as the result of a sudden catastrophic heart attack. Marion "Van" was an Orlando native, and lifelong resident. He attended Kaley Elementary, Cherokee Junior High, and Boone High School. Van graduated Boone High School in 1957, and a few years later, enlisted in the Army. He met his wife of 51 years while stationed at Fort Monmouth, New Jersey. Van was part of U.S. Army's frontline defense in Eastern Europe during the Cuban Missile Crisis. Upon honorable discharge from the Army, he and his wife, Elizabeth moved back to Orlando. Van worked as a salesman for most of his career. He was an avid outdoorsman, enjoying hunting and fishing. Van also enjoyed a variety of sports both as an athlete in his youth, and as a fan in his adult years. He is predeceased by his wife, Elizabeth Morson Van Trump.
