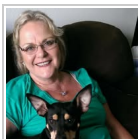

I just found out, Prayers for the family he will be missed by many here in Jacksonville I knew Mike for 40 years and I will miss him very much R.i.p. Big guy..

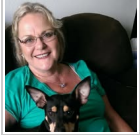
