Michael used this talent for the greater good. As most of you know shortly, after his 20th birthday, Michael was diagnosed with Leukemia. This began his three (3) year battle with cancer. While Michael was receiving his treatment he didn't think about himself. Instead, he thought about what he could do to help and unite others who were going through the same thing. He wanted to help others feel strong; to feel that they have this fight, and to let them know that they are exceptional. With this thought in mind Michael came up with his dream to connect others through dance and music.

Michael accomplished so much during his 23 years on this earth. He graduated from the University of Central Florida with a degree in Marketing. He was full of adventure. He never hesitated to jump at the opportunity to have fun. He went skydiving. He travelled all over the U.S. to places like Las Vegas, Vermont; he even ventured out to the Bahamas. He went skydiving, skiing, and enjoyed the shows in Las Vegas. He loved visiting the Disney Parks. He enjoyed going to concerts. He truly enjoyed living life to the fullest. Michael's favorite holiday was Christmas. He would have been happy to see everyone together during this festive time of year.

Michael had a lot of choices when it came to careers, but he was most drawn

to helping others. With this goal in mind, Michael began a nonprofit called Zealot Clouds, which he created for the purpose of producing and sharing videos he envisioned would help other cancer patients, survivors, and caregivers. Michael choreographed his videos in hopes that they would boost the spirits of others that might be going through the same or similar disease and give strength to remind them keep fighting. The ultimate goal was to connect everyone, no matter what race, creed, sex, religious beliefs, and give them a chance to realize they are able to rise above whatever ailment they are going through; that they are not alone; and that they are all in it together. The concept of his videos has inspired many of us.

Michael was selfless and caring. Michael's very last post on Facebook on November 24, 2017, was a dance video tribute to two other cancer survivors. The purpose of the video was to provide happiness and strength to them and their family members. He was truly a caring, loving young man. He touched many hearts in so many ways.

Michael also had many people that cared for him. He was appreciative to those who provided support throughout his fight with cancer. He was especially appreciative to those who stayed by his side until those final days. Although it is sad to see so much potential passing away so young, it is comforting that he was able to share his journey in such a impactful way. He was a fighter. He was a warrior. His strength is commendable and admirable.

Now he is literally dancing in the stars. His spirit will remain in all of our hearts. Our love for him is forever. May he rest in peace.

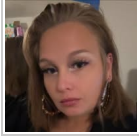

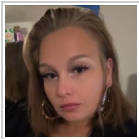

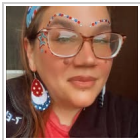
