Mohan Permanand, aka Suresh was born on Sunday, April 4, 1954. He was the only son of Cyril and Latchmin Permanand (Nanan and Madam). Together with his parents and two sisters, Saroj and Nal he grew up at La Union, West Coast Demerara. Suresh attended Crane Primary School and then Central High School.

His career began as Pharmacy Technician at Prashad's Hospital, after which he worked at DDL, Demerara Distillers Ltd. After a 15 year tenure, he ended his professional career and engaged in the self-employed business of rice farming.

On March 4, 1979, Suresh married the love of his life Vidoutie Persaud, aka Vedo. Together they started their family, and were blessed with two sons Dave and Vivakh. From their son's marriages, Dave to Amanda and Vivakh to Nikki, blossomed three adorable grandsons, Varun, Rudra and Kian. Suresh loved his grandsons more than life.

Suresh was a kind, loving, hardworking, caring individual, who would always go above and beyond to provide for his family, and to help others. He attended Mandir regularly, and participate in puja and other events. Suresh was well read in our Hindu scriptures, and he was always willing to share his knowledge of same.

On February 6, 2015, Suresh and Vedo migrated to Orlando, Florida, which was a life changing experience. In 2018, his illnesses began to progress. He braved many surgeries, hospitalization periods and various treatments for his multi-complications, piand has always recovered to the best of his ability.

During his illness, Suresh and Vedo visited Guyana several times, the children were his life he was a proud father and grandfather. He was always excited to take these trips to spend time with them. His last visit home to Guyana was in April, 2021, where he celebrated his 67th birthday with family and friends by performing puja and offerings to Bhagwan.

In August, 2021, Suresh fell ill once more, but his recovery was not as fortunate as before. On September 19, 2021, he drew his final breath, freeing himself from this material world.

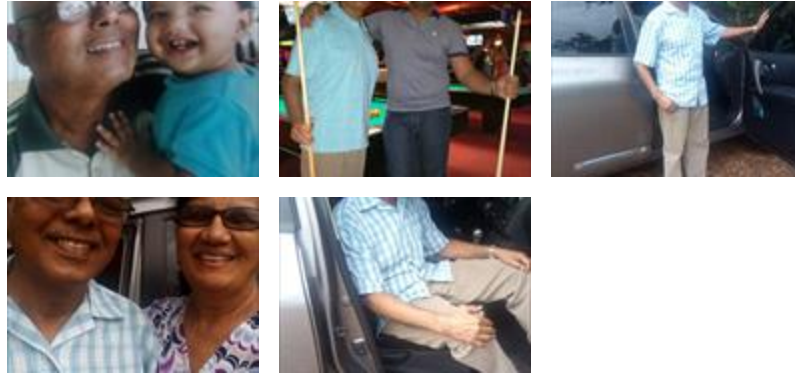
