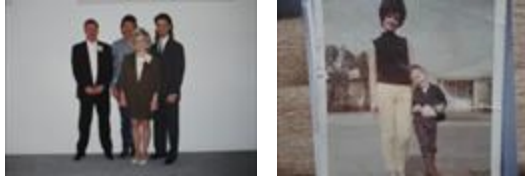

She used to ask me to get my guitar and sing her a song. She would sit there and listen to something I had written then tell me how it was a hit song. She'd say, "That was a great one,baby" and even if I knew better it was still wonderful to hear.

Yvonne told me not long ago that life was all about the little moments that we have together and how we should give people memories, instead of gifts. I've got a feeling that she was exactly right, and the most import thing we can do for anyone is to share our time and make memories. Please remember that the next time someone you love wants to spend time with you, " go make a memory".
