



Mrs. Pauline Louise Bouchard

Pauline L. Bouchard 94, of Orlando, Florida passed away on November 22, 2016 in her apartment at Orlando Lutheran Towers. She was born on September 20, 1922, in Topsham, Maine, daughter of Joseph and Eugenie (Michaud) Pelletier.

She did third shift work in a textile factory during her younger years and became a devoted wife in 1946 and beloved mother. She moved with her husband and their first four children from Maine to the warmer temperatures in Florida leaving all her extended family behind. Communication with family in Maine was limited at that time, so it was difficult at first and she was homesick. However, she persevered and became a strong, independent woman. She instilled manners, moral values and ethics into her children.

She and Alpee had three more children while in Florida. She liked the beach and would spend a lot of time there while the children were growing up. Once the children were older she and her beloved husband traveled. They enjoyed flying in airplanes and taking cruises. In her 70's she took up golf and would go with her husband to a course nearby to play at least a couple times a week.

She was a faithful Catholic and tried to say her rosary daily. She used to name each family member in her prayers, until the family started getting too large -

then she started grouping members of a family together. She loved her children but loved her grandchildren even more since she could “return them” to their parents if they misbehaved. And her grandchildren loved her very deeply as well and enjoyed spending time with her.

Pauline was predeceased by her husband Alphee P. Bouchard, her son Michael P. Bouchard, two great-granddaughters Corynne and Cathryn Bouchard, her parents and all 10 Pelletier siblings: Arthur, Omar, Freda and husband Sylvio LaMarque, Claire and husband Irene Pelletier, twin brother Paul and wife Ada (Scott), Theresa and husband Robert Favreau, George and wife Doris (Bouchard), Sister Georgette, Sister Mathias (Florence), and Simonne Tetu.

She is survived by 6 of her 7 children – son James Bouchard, daughter Susan and husband Robert O’Connor, daughter Karen and husband Michael Walton, son Kim and wife Theo (Toth) Bouchard, daughter Tina and husband James DeFelice, and daughter Lisa and husband Rick Johnson. Also surviving are 18 grandchildren, 28 great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren, her brother-in-law George Tetu as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

A celebration of Pauline’s life will be held on Saturday December 10 at 2:00 PM in the Orlando Lutheran Towers Chapel at 300 East Church Street, Orlando, Florida.
